1) What is the purpose of students attending these events?

These events are required by the Diocese of Camden for all students grades 1-8 enrolled in Summer PREP to increase student knowledge of the Catholic faith.

2) How do these events encourage and prepare students to witness their faith?

“Stand up and Serve Bag Lunch Project” and “Casserole Making” encourage a missionary spirit that prepares the youth to be present as Christians in society and share their faith journey as an inspiration and example to others.

3) How do these events help students to participate more fully in liturgy?

“My Faith Journey” TED talks, “Bible Storytime” and “Snacks with the Saints.” These events promote knowledge of the meaning of liturgy. Students meet with Incarnation’s parishioners who will share their stories of how they have come to know and experience Christ in their lives through participation in the sacraments.

Family Pro-Life Rosary: First Saturday of the month 9am-9:30am. Meet in the back of church at the end of Mass. The group will proceed to the pro-life monument or the Mary Grotto if weather permits, or pray in the church. **Beginning 9/7/2019.**

Incarnation Sports Club: Open to boys only, grades 7-8. This is our weekly basketball open session and is held **every Thursday. Arrive at 7:15pm** and sign in to be placed on a team. Teams play several games and break in the middle for a short bible study and video. Note this is only for athletes with prior experience playing basketball and should be intermediate-advanced players.

Crochet Ministry: For those wanting to learn to crochet, open to middle school age and up. **Meets Thursday evenings from 6-8:30pm** during the school year.
